Please find below five short day excursions that we are planning to run to ease you into the swing of things. Where for comfort and safety the following will take place

- Any coach used will be at half capacity to allow for social distancing. ie only 25 persons maximum, on our 53 seat coach.
- Extra cleaning of common touch areas like handrails will be undertaken
- Before and after trips the vehicles will be disinfected.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for use, though it is recommended you provide your own if possible
- Face coverings must be worn in line with Government guidance at all times on board the coach.

All Excursions will Depart Bradford Nelson Street 10.00am . Returning for approx. 16.00

There are planned to be at least 2 hours at the destination.

Depart Code A, ie usual pick up points AFTER Bradford, towards Keighley 45 minutes later.

**Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July – Grassington** - a beautiful village in Upper Wharfedale's stunning scenery, with a sense of history, great shops, and lovely walks.

**Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> July - Clitheroe** - Set in the glorious Ribble Valley, Clitheroe is a regional market town, overlooked by what is said to be the smallest Norman castle in England, home to a Museum and set 16 acres of landscaped gardens.

**Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July – Pateley Bridge** - Nestled in the heart of Nidderdale, an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, you can experience all the charms of rural life as well as visit numerous quaint local shops, including Englands Oldest Sweet Shop.

**Monday 27<sup>th</sup> July – Harrogate** - the definitive boutique spa town in the heart of Yorkshire, with its vast open space that surrounds the town centre, including the Stray and Valley Gardens in which to stroll.

**Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> July – Settle** – a historic market town in one of the most scenic areas of the Yorkshire Dales, there is heritage, culture, retail and walks to enjoy.
