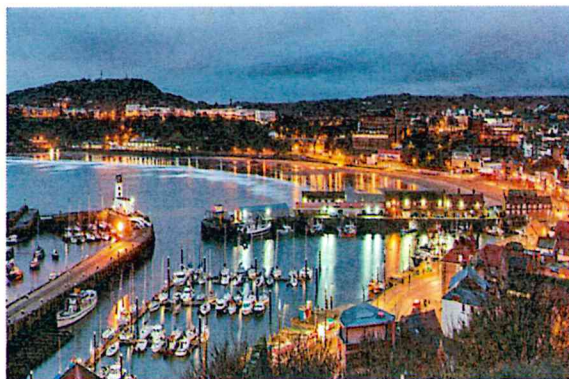

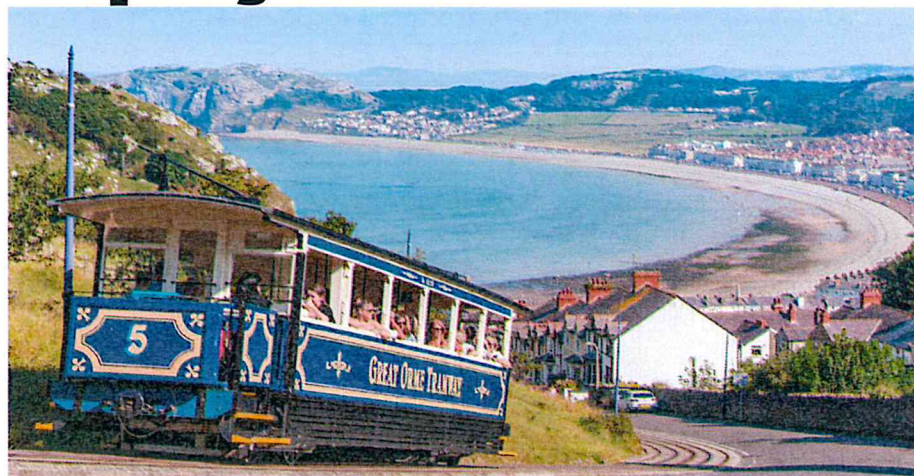

March & April

Saturday 2nd March. Engine Driver's Fish & Chips.

£54.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30.

We start with a scenic trip over the Pennines to Heywood for a ride on the award winning East Lancashire preserved railway where we take in the views of the valley as we travel by steam train to Rawtenstall (NB subject to locomotive availability). We then travel for a late lunch of delicious fish and chips at the Olympus Fish Restaurant in Bolton.

Saturday 16th March. Nunnington Hall.

We visit Nunnington Hall near York, beautifully situated on the River Rye, where you can learn about the history of the various families who have lived there. Inside the house is the famous Carlisle Collection of miniature rooms and outside you can relax in the spring wildflower meadows and fruit orchards.

Saturday 30th March. Lakes & Daffodils.

Monday 1st April. Through the Forest of Bowland to Morecambe.

Barnard Castle is a market town on the banks of the River Tees, built around the ruins of the castle.

Saturday 27th April. Pendle Village Mill & Lytham St Annes.

Pendle Village hosts independent brands both small and large including gifts, home décor and a garden centre as well as a restaurant to enjoy. Lytham is an ever popular resort with golden sands.

September

Wednesday 4th September.

Richmond & Kiplin Hall.

£42.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 18.00.

Richmond is one of Britain's most beautiful and vibrant market towns. Today is a market day, with its iconic castle, fine historic buildings, sweeping cobbled market place and leafy riverside vistas, it is the original of no less than 105 worldwide Richmonds. In the afternoon we visit Kiplin Hall with a guided tour of this lovingly cherished family home, surrounded by gardens restored to their former glory.

Friday 6th September.

Thirsk & Helmsley Market.

Saturday 7th September.

The Lakes & Keswick.

We enjoy the beautiful scenery of the Lakes, with a call at Ambleside, on the way to the delightful market town of Keswick situated on the edge of Derwentwater, where today its bustling market will be open.

Thursday 12th September.

Ormskirk Market & Southport.

We visit Ormskirk on market day, with the market being one of the oldest in the country. There are up to 100 stalls specialising in food and drink, but with a selection of stalls offering household goods, gifts etc. From here we visit Southport with Lord Street which is famous for its shops, plus beach and gardens.

Tees Princess with Lunch.

A roast beef or roast chicken, or vegetarian option of nut roast lunch, followed by dessert will be served as we glide along the river enjoying the scenery. (choice required on booking).



Saturday 21st September.

Northallerton Market & Wensleydale Railway.

A morning visit to Northallerton on a market day, and time to explore its other attractions. We then view the delights of Wensleydale from the train whilst travelling between Leeming Bar and Leyburn, with time in Leyburn before the journey home.

Thursday 8th August. Brief Encounter to Morecambe. £32.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.
We make a morning call at Carnforth Station, forever associated with the 1945 classic film "Brief Encounter", where there is a visitor centre and café. We continue to Morecambe to admire the views of the bay from the restored promenade.

Saturday 10th August. Portmeirion. £59.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.00 - Return for 20.00.
We travel through spectacular Snowdonian scenery to Portmeirion, a magnificent Italianate coastal village created by Sir Clough Williams-Ellis. With its cluster of colour washed houses set around a central piazza, historic cottages and woodlands, the village achieved cult status as the setting for the 1960's TV series 'The Prisoner'.

Tuesday 13th August. Shackleton's & Lytham. £32.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.30 - Return for 18.30.
We start the day with a call at the ever popular Shackleton's Home & Garden Centre where there is an excellent gift shop, in addition to the expected plants and gardening accessories. We then visit Lytham with its beach and range of shops.

Thursday 15th August. Denby Pottery & The Heights of Abraham at Matlock Bath.
£48.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.
We call at the Denby Pottery outlet en route to the popular town of Matlock Bath with its quaint shops and attractive riverside gardens. We then take the cable car to the Heights of Abraham, with its spectacular views and attractions.

Saturday 17th August. Southport at Flower Show Time. £34.25pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.
Southport offers a mix of old fashioned elegance with its shopping arcades on Lord Street, plus attractions of a refurbished pier and promenade gardens. Our visit coincides with the famous annual flower shows 100th Anniversary with its huge range of displays, stalls and show gardens. (Admission is NOT included).

Tuesday 20th August. RHS Bridgewater. £32.95pp. Depart code B.
Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30. RHS Discount -£9.00
The newest of RHS gardens offers a range of attractions including extensive walled gardens, both flower and vegetable. There are woodland walks for you to enjoy together with the evolving Chinese Garden. There is a lovely café situated at the edge of a lake and shop with a plant centre.

Thursday 22nd August. Port Sunlight. £42.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.
Today we visit the 'model village' founded by the Soap King, William Hesketh Lever in 1888 for his factory workers. We will have a guided tour on the coach to view the village which is also home to a world class art gallery.

Saturday 24th August. Hexham & Wallington Hall. £61.95pp. Depart code B.
Depart 08.30 - Return for 20.00. National Trust Discount -£17.00
We visit the historic market town of Hexham, with its famous Abbey, and the Old Gaol which is now a museum. The town has a variety of shops from the unusual independents to national chains. Wallington Hall houses the treasures collected by 10 generations of the families, whilst the Walled Garden is regarded as one of the finest in the country.

Monday 26th August. Kirkby Lonsdale, Appleby & Hawes. £35.45pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.
Kirkby Lonsdale is a delightful little town with a range of attractive cafes, shops and a beautiful riverside walk along the banks of the Rive Lune. This is followed by a scenic drive to the historic market town of Appleby and then via Ais Gill to our final destination of Hawes, before heading home via Ribbleshead.

Wednesday 28th August. Llandudno. £43.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 20.00.
A jewel amongst Victorian resorts Llandudno has a sweeping promenade, a beautiful pier and the Great Orme Headland rising above the town. There is a variety of shops, cafes and restaurants to enjoy.

Saturday 31st August. Beverley & Bridlington. £36.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.
We visit the delightful market town of Beverley on market day, where you will find a mix of stalls in the town square including food, clothing and gifts. From here we travel to the traditional seaside resort of Bridlington.

Saturday 4th May. Thirsk & Saltburn.
£34.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.
We make a morning call at the popular market town of Thirsk, before continuing to Saltburn-by-the-Sea, which has maintained much of its original charm as a Victorian seaside resort including its pier, colourful Italian Gardens and popular walks. Saltburn has the oldest water balanced cliff tramway in Britain that is still in operation, linking the town with the pier 120 feet below. You can visit the old fishing village which straddles Skelton Beck where The Ship Inn remains a focal point, steeped in smuggling folklore.

Monday 6th May. Kirkby Lonsdale, Cartmel & Grange over Sands.
£32.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.
We start with a visit to Kirkby Lonsdale, situated on the River Lune with its attractive shops, cafes and walks. Cartmel is a small village famous both for its ancient priory and also its sticky toffee pudding shop. Grange-over-Sands is an elegant town with strong reminders of its heyday as a fashionable 19th century seaside resort.

Saturday 11th May. North York Moors Railway to Whitby.
£58.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00. Returns for 19.30.
We take a ride by steam train on the North Yorks Moors Railway from Pickering enjoying the spectacular scenery on the line to Whitby. Once in Whitby you will have the chance to enjoy the attractions of this delightful resort. The return journey, by coach, takes in the majestic moorland views (NB steam engine subject to availability).

Sunday 19th May. Buxton & Cream Tea Cruise on the Judith Mary.

Taking in the beautiful Dales scenery on a run via Kidstone Pass to our first stop at Aysgarth, with time to stroll to the falls if you wish, before we visit the lovely market town of Richmond. The town is famous for its castle, range of shops, and historic market square.

Wednesday 29th May. RHS Bridgewater.
£32.95pp. Depart code B.
Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30.
RHS Reduction -£9.00
The newest of the RHS Gardens offers a range of attractions including extensive walled gardens, both flower and vegetable. There are woodland walks to enjoy as well as the developing Chinese Gardens. There is a lovely tea room situated on the edge of a lake, with a shop and extensive garden centre.



June

Saturday 1st June. Lowther Castle.

£47.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return 18.30. Historic Houses Association Discount -£10.00

Lowther Castle in Cumbria is where only the external walls of the castle remain, providing a wonderful backdrop to the splendid 130 acre gardens. These include the Rose Garden, Parterre, and wildflower meadows. There is also an exhibition detailing the history of the Lowther family.

Wednesday 5th June. Llandudno.

£43.95pp. Depart code B. Departs 09.00 - Return 20.00.

A jewel amongst Victorian resorts, Llandudno has a sweeping promenade, a beautiful pier and the Great Orme headland rising above the town. There is a variety of shops and cafes for you to enjoy.

Saturday 8th June.

Yorkshire Lavender & Scarborough.

Llangollen & Pontcysyllte Aqueduct.

In the picturesque town of Llangollen, situated on the banks of the River Dee, you can enjoy the attractions which include the heritage steam railway, Plas Newydd House and a riverside walk. (Admission to these attractions not included). To finish our day we join a narrow boat for a trip on the Llangollen Canal across the spectacular Pontcysyllte Aqueduct. Built in 1805, it is the oldest and longest navigable aqueduct in the UK as well as the highest in the world at over 100 feet.

Saturday 22nd June.

High Leigh Garden Centre & Jodrell Bank.

£42.95pp Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00

High Leigh in Cheshire is an award winning home and garden centre, with a delightful relaxed coffee shop to enjoy before we travel to Jodrell Bank - a unique and amazing place. We will discover its story and that of the Lovell Telescope in a talk given by one of the Explainers. Outside there are 35 acres of beautiful grounds to explore with an Exhibition and Telescope Pathway. (NB other Space Dome shows are available – but not included).



Saturday 29th June. Arley Hall Garden Festival.

£41.95pp Depart code B Depart 10.00 - Return for 17.30

We visit stunning Arley Hall for the famous annual garden festival with its floral marquee, plant nursery, display gardens, gardeners question time and guided tours of the gardens. There will be plant, gardening accessories, craft and food stalls offering their wares.

July & August

Thursday 11th July. Great Yorkshire Show.

£53.95pp. Depart code B. Departs 09.15 - Return for 17.00.

Enjoy a day at the 165th celebration of agriculture, food, farming and countryside as well as the best in British livestock, forestry, hives and honey. There is a fabulous food hall, cookery demonstrations, garden shows and countryside pursuits.

Saturday 13th July. Tynemouth.

£38.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

We visit one of the most popular towns on the North Tyneside coast, Tynemouth, which is situated at the mouth of the River Tyne under the gaze of the ruined medieval priory, and the town is steeped in maritime history, plus today the award winning market is taking place.

Saturday 20th July. Wentworth Woodhouse.

£34.50pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.15 - Return for 16.00.

Wentworth Woodhouse is one of the grandest stately homes in the country, Grade 1 listed and at the beginning of an ambitious restoration project, where we enjoy a guided tour. At present only the State Rooms of the 365 room Mansion are available to visit, due to ongoing work. The gardens include a wildflower meadow, woodland copses and 18th century follies, across 50 acres.

Thursday 25th July. Whitby.

£36.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Returns for 19.00.

We travel to the ever popular resort of Whitby, enjoying spectacular views across the North Yorks Moors. There are various attractions in this thriving resort including the famous abbey, with the 199 steps leading to it, the vibrant harbour and range of shops.

Saturday 27th July. Bodnant Gardens.

£54.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return for 18.30. NT Reduction -£14.00

Bodnant Gardens is a Grade 1 listed garden and is one of Wales's finest formal gardens, situated in Snowdonia's foothills. Five generations of the family have transformed the 80 acre Conwy Valley hillside with rare trees and shrubs from around the world. The garden ranges from formal Italianate terraces, to informal woodlands, meadows with rivers walks.

Tuesday 30th July. "Another Place" Crosby & Liverpool.

Another Place is the name for the 100 spectacular Anthony Gormley statues situated on Crosby beach – our day starts here when the tide is favourable for a viewing, before heading on to the Albert Dock area of Liverpool where you will have time to peruse its many attractions.

Thursday 1st August. Scarborough on Yorkshire Day.

Saturday 3rd August. Pateley Bridge & St Wilfrids Procession, Ripon.
