Saturday 7th June.

Raby Castle.

£49.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return 18.00.

The castle, near Barnard Castle, is home to Lord and Lady Raby, is set amidst spectacular grounds and gardens. Built in the 14th century by the powerful Neville family, the castle has chequered history, whilst the formal gardens, lake and deer park are a true delight.

Saturday 14th June.

Breezy Knees - The Flower Garden of Yorkshire.

£38.95pp. Depart code B. Departs 09.30 - Return 17.00.

Vibrant gardens, sparkling fountains and a myriad of spectacular colours await you at Breezy Knees, near York. Now covering 20 acres, it is one of the largest gardens in the North of England with over 10,000 different varieties of plants. There is lots to see with extensive borders that form the heart of the garden as well as a cafe and plant nursery.

Saturday 21st June.

Chesterfield & Bolsover Castle.

£45.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return 18.00. EH Reduction - £13.00

We start the day at Chesterfield, famous for its church with the crooked spire and today also happens to be Market Day. Bolsover Castle is unusual in that it is neither a castle or a stately home, but a fantasy hilltop pleasure palace of a horse mad Cavalier playboy. It features an astonishing riding house, featuring carved fire places, painted panelling and dramatic murals. The elevation of the castle provides you with panoramic views of the Derbyshire countryside.

Saturday 28th June.

Arley Hall Garden Festival

30th Anniversary Show. £42.95pp.

Depart code B. Depart 10.00 - Return for 17.30.

We visit stunning Arley Hall, set in 15 acres of gardens, famous for the annual garden festival with its floral marquee, plant nursery, display gardens and double herbaceous border. Also gardener's question time and guided tours of the gardens, when available.



Thursday 10th July.

Great Yorkshire Show.

£56.45pp. Depart code B. Departs 09.15 - Return for 17.00.

Enjoy a day at the celebration of agriculture, food, farming and countryside as well as the best in British livestock, forestry, hives and honey. There is a fabulous food hall, cookery demonstrations, garden shows and countryside pursuits.

Saturday 12th July.

Lincoln & Belton House.

£57.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return for 19.00. NT Discount -£20.00

Lincoln is dominated by the magnificent cathedral, which for over two centuries was the tallest building in the world. Nearby is Steep Hill, leading down to the main shopping area. Belton house boasts an impressive art, silver and porcelain collection as well as a world renowned library.

July

Thursday 17th July. RHS Wentworth Woodhouse.

£59.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.00. RHS Discount -£5.00

For the first time ever the *RHS Flower Show* is being held at *Wentworth Woodhouse*, in South Yorkshire. The show is being held in the grounds of the largest country house in the UK, boasting over fifty acres of beautiful gardens. There will be vibrant displays, expert talks, workshops and colourful gardening inspiration. Plus chance to visit the mansion itself.

Saturday 19th July. Tynemouth.

£39.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Returns for 19.00.

We visit one of the most popular towns on the North Tyneside coast, Tynemouth, which is situated at the mouth of the River Tyne, under the gaze of the ruined medieval priory and the town is steeped in maritime history, plus the award winning market is taking place today.

Tuesday 22nd July. Burnby Hall Gardens & Bridlington.

£43.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

Burnby Hall and Gardens is situated in the charming town of Pocklington, and is a seven times winner of the RHS Yorkshire in Bloom award. The gardens comprise upper and lower lakes set in nine acres of woodlands and gardens. From here, we travel to the ever popular resort of Bridlington where you will have a chance to take in the variety of attractions.

Thursday 24th July. Lake District - Ambleside & Coniston.

£35.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.30 - Return for 19.00.

We take a scenic drive through the Lake District taking in the spectacular views including stops at the bustling lakeside towns of Ambleside and Coniston where you will have a chance to explore.

Saturday 26th July. Peak District - Glossop Market & Castleton.

£28.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 18.00.

We visit Glossop, a market town set in the borough of High Peak. Today is market day so you can browse the outdoor stalls at your leisure. From here we take a scenic drive through High Peak to the picturesque village of Castleton. The village is popular for its history, show caves and shops.

Monday 28th July. Thirsk Market & Mount Grace Priory.

£38.50pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 18.00. EH Reduction -£10.00pp

We visit Thirsk on market day, which takes place in the town's traditional cobbled square, offering fresh local produce. Mount Grace Priory is the best preserved Carthusian priory in England, and includes a reconstructed monk's cell and garden.

Wednesday 30th July. Leyburn & Bolton Castle.

£42.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 18.30.

We take a scenic drive through the Yorkshire Dales to the market town of Leyburn. Then, on to the 14th century Bolton Castle, to view the ruins of this once magnificent castle, and experience birds of prey and archery exhibitions, whilst enjoying views of Swaledale and Coverdale.

August

Friday 1st August. Scarborough on Yorkshire Day.

£35.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

We visit the ever popular resort of Scarborough with its range of attractions to suit everyone. As today is Yorkshire Day there will be an Artisan Yorkshire Market, as well as live entertainment.

Saturday 2nd August. Chester & The Anderton Boat Lift.

£47.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return for 18.00.

We make a morning visit to the delightful cathedral city of Chester, before visiting the Anderton Boat Lift. This is one of only two working boat lifts in the UK, and is a 50 foot vertical link between the River Weaver and the Trent & Mersey Canal. Built in 1875 it is a scheduled monument, and you can enjoy the thrill of a ride between the two waterways.

Monday 4th August. Darlington & Locomotion for SD200.

£31.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

This year marks the 200th anniversary of the opening of the Stockton and Darlington Railway, which revolutionised transport. You can either spend time in Darlington, or explore the town's railway heritage. We move on to Locomotion at Shildon, situated by the original S&D line where you'll find the Exhibition Hall telling more of the railway story.

Wednesday 6th August. Liverpool Bay Cruise.

£58.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 19.30.

We enjoy a unique 3 hour cruise of Liverpool Bay with Mersey Ferries. There will be expert commentary from a Blue Badge Guide as you take in the panorama of the river shore and sea front, passing the famous docks along the Crosby Channel towards Formby. The return run follows the route of the cruise liners from the Irish Sea, giving the magic feeling of sailing into Liverpool.

Saturday 9th August. Althrop House.

£64.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return for 19.30.

Althrop has been home to the Spencer family for over 500 years and contains a fascinating variety of pictures, furniture, ceramics and fine interiors. Childhood home and final resting place of Diana, Princess of Wales.

Monday 11th August. Whitby.

£36.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

Travelling across the North Yorkshire Moors, taking in the spectacular scenery we visit Whitby with its numerous attractions. These include the ruins of the Abbey, St Mary's Church at the top of the famous 199 steps, whilst the town offers a range of shops and cafes to enjoy.

Wednesday 13th August. Ripon & The Himalayan Garden.

£39.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 17.30.

First call is Ripon, famous for its Minster, and market square with its attractive buildings. Then, to the Himalayan Garden, a botanical masterpiece, the gardens, arboretum, and a Sculpture Park are set in stunning woodland. (NB Not suitable for those with impaired mobility).

Saturday 16th August. Seahouses with Billy Shiel Boats.

£64.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return for 20.00.

Stopping at the picturesque town of Bedale for a mid-morning break, we travel to the coastal village of Seahouses. In addition to being able to explore the village you will enjoy a 90 minute grey seal cruise, which takes you around all of the Farne islands, where at this time of year will give you the chance to see thousands of seabirds including puffins.

August

Monday 18th August. Llandudno.

£43.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 20.00.

A jewel amongst Victorian resorts, Llandudno has a sweeping promenade, a beautiful pier and the Great Orme headland. There is a wide variety of attractions, shops and cafes to explore and enjoy.

Wednesday 20th August. Nostell Priory.

£33.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 10.30 - Return for 17.00. NT Discount -£11.00

Nostell is one of the north of England's great treasure houses. It is a Georgian architectural masterpiece that was built to impress. There is world class Thomas Chippendale furniture, textiles and wallpaper, along with historic paintings and a treasured Georgian Dolls' House.

The 300 acre estate includes a lake, parkland, and a working kitchen garden.

Friday 22nd August.

Helmsley Market & Helmsley Walled Garden.

£36.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30. Returns for 17.30.

We visit Helmsley on market day, where the stalls are set out in the historic centre of the town and are surrounded by local shops and cafes.

Helmsley Walled Garden was built in 1759 and has vibrant borders, glasshouses and apple orchards. The Vine House café offers fresh food using quality ingredients from the Walled Garden where possible.



Saturday 23rd August. Tees Princess Cruise with Roast Lunch.

£58.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.45 - Return for 19.00.

The Teesside Princess cruises along the River Tees with a non stop return journey between Stockton-on- Tees and Yarm, taking in tranquil surroundings on this 3 hour cruise whilst enjoying a roast beef or roast chicken lunch, (vegetarian option of nut roast) followed by dessert (choice required on booking). We then call at Yarm on our return coach journey.

Monday 25th August. Dales Scenic Drive.

£30.45pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

We travel to the delightful village of Kettlewell for a mid-morning break, before travelling to Hawes, which includes the World-famous Wensleydale Creamery. There are plenty of traditional shops and places to eat. From here we will enjoy beautiful scenery as we travel to Kirkby Lonsdale with its selection of independent shops and cafes along the main street, before journeying home.

Wednesday 27th August. Brockholes Nature Reserve & Cleveleys.

£32.25pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

Brockholes, near Preston, is a former quarry which has been transformed into a haven for birds, insects, mammals and plants. Here you have trails to explore, beautiful lakes and woodland.

From here we visit the traditional seaside resort of Cleveleys with its golden sands and walks along its award winning promenade.

Saturday 30th August. Lake District - Grasmere & Keswick.

£39.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.30 - Return for 19.30.

Following a brief mid-morning stop in Settle, we travel to Grasmere where there are a variety of shops and cafes to explore. Then on to Keswick, where today is market day with stalls set out in the Square and adjoining area offering gifts and locally produced food. Derwentwater is a short stroll away as is Hope Park with its stunning gardens and views.

September

Monday 1st September. Cleethorpes

£35.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

Cleethorpes is a seaside town on the Humber Estuary, with traditional attractions including lovely sandy beaches, pier, promenade, ice cream and fish and chips !

Wednesday 3rd September. Train to Appleby & Barnard Castle.

£54.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.30 - Return for 18.00.

We take a scenic train ride from Keighley to Appleby taking in the magnificent views of this section of the Settle to Carlisle line. There will be time to explore this attractive market town before we join the coach for the journey to Barnard Castle. Today is market day where the stalls offer a wide range from crafts to street food, together with delicious local treats in a friendly atmosphere.

Sunday 7th September.

Manchester Airport or Quarry Bank Mill.

£27.25pp. Airport Viewing Area

£50.25pp. Quarry Bank Mill NT Discount -£20.00

Depart code B. Depart 09.30. Returns for 17.00.

Either visit the Runway Visitor Park at Manchester Airport, one of the North West's most popular outdoor attractions, with live commentary about the aviation action taking place nearby, and a variety of retired aircraft including a Concorde, (admission not included) RAF Nimrod spy plane and Trident to visit.

OR visit Quarry Bank Mill, a giant cotton mill with the heritage machinery still in place, as well as the owners home - Quarry Bank House. Apprentice House used to house and feed the child labour. Styal Village was built to house the workers, with picturesque gardens on the river banks.



Thursday 11th September. Ormskirk Market & Southport.

£34.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

We visit Ormskirk on market day, where approximately 100 stalls are situated around the famous Clock Tower. Southport is a delightful resort popular for the shopping on Lord Street and the delightful gardens near the pier.

Saturday 13th September. Sherwood Forest & Newstead Abbey.

£50.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

Sherwood Forest Visitor Centre is the gateway to this historic forest, where you can walk to the 'Major Oak' believed to be between 800 -1,100 years old and according to legend sheltered Robin Hood. Newstead Abbey dates from the late 12th century and was home to the famous poet Lord Byron. We will enjoy an hours guided tour of this Abbey home, and have time to wander outside to visit the formal and themed gardens, lake and park walks.

Friday 19th September. Harrogate Autumn Flower Show.

£49.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 18.00.

The Autumn Show will be held in the grounds of Newby Hall, where you will also be able to enjoy Newby Hall's award winning gardens. There will be the Grand Flower Pavilion, live talks, and an amazing array of garden related exhibitors, as well as a covered Food Market.

October

Saturday 4th October. North Yorks Moors to Whitby.

£59.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return 19.00.

We take a ride by steam train on the North York Moors Railway from Pickering enjoying spectacular scenery to Whitby. Once in Whitby you will have a chance to enjoy the attractions of this delightful resort. The return journey, by coach, takes in the majestic moorland views.

(NB steam engine subject to availability).

Wednesday 8th October. Bury Market including Fish & Chips.

£40.45pp. Depart code A. Departs 09.30 - Return 18.00.

From the exotic to the everyday Bury Market has it all, with over 200 stalls you are sure to find whatever you want at bargain prices. From here we travel to the award winning Olympus Fish and Chip restaurant in Bolton for a traditional meal of cod, chips, peas, bread and butter with tea or coffee.

Wednesday 15th October. Autumn Colours - Richmond & Aysgarth Falls.

£27.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return 17.30.

We visit the market town of Richmond, with its cobbled streets overshadowed by the ruins of the imposing castle. Here there is a host of individual shops, eateries and cultural and heritage attractions. From here we take a scenic drive to Aysgarth Falls where you will have a chance to visit the falls, and nearby shops. Returning via the dramatic Kidstones Pass.

Saturday 18th October. Autumn Colours - Dalby Forest & Scarborough.

£35.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

We visit the Dalby Forest Visitor Centre, nestled in the heart of the Low Dalby valley. You can explore the immediate area, enjoy the shops and café. From here we travel to the ever popular resort of Scarborough with its numerous attractions.

Thursday 23rd October.

Pendle Mill, Lytham St Anne's & Blackpool Lights

£35.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

We visit Pendle Village Mill Shopping Centre, where there are departments offering clothing, shoes, household and a garden centre. Onwards to Lytham St Anne's to enjoy the elegant shops and promenade. We will then enjoy a drive through the world famous lights of Blackpool from the comfort of our coach.

Saturday 25th October.

Hull & The Deep.

£44.75pp. Depart code B.

Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.00.

We travel to Hull where you will have time to explore this rejuvenated city as well as visiting the award winning 'The Deep'. The aquarium has numerous highlights, from the underwater tunnel with sharks above you to the beauty of the jellyfish. Also, amongst others, you can see turtles, penguins and stingrays. Amongst the attractions of Hull itself is the bustling marina whilst Hull Minster is worth a visit.
