

Kirkby Lonsdale, Appleby and Hawes Scenic Tour

Saturday 25th August 2018

Beautiful scenery and delightful little towns are the order of the day. Starting with a visit to Kirkby Lonsdale for a mid morning break, the town has a range of superb cafes and shops for you to enjoy. There are spectacular views over the River Lune from a viewpoint which John Ruskin described as the finest in England. From here we travel to the historic market town of Appleby situated by the River Eden, where you have a chance to explore before we travel via Ais Gill to our final destination. Llangollen & Pontcysyllte Viaduct

In the picturesque town of Llangollen, on the banks of the River Dee, you can enjoy the sights of this delightful town with attractions including a heritage steam railway, horse drawn canal boat trips, and Plas Newydd (former home of the "Ladies of Llangollen")(NB admissions not included). To finish our day we take a narrowboat trip on the Llangollen Canal, across the spectacular Pontcysyllte Aqueduct. Liverpool Biennial – "Beautiful World, where are you?"

Monday 27th August 2018

In addition to the usual attractions of Liverpool which include the magnificent cathedrals, the Docks, the Museums, and Liverpool shopping centres, the city celebrates its annual International Beatele week. In addition, a biennial festival with the theme "Beautiful World, where are you?" will be in full swing displaying a wide range of contemporary art, whose previous contributors have included Yoko Ono and Ai Weiwei. Clitheroe Market & Samlesbury Hall

The house has many beautiful rooms with magnificent furniture and artwork, including the Princess of Wales State Bedroom and the Library, which was at one time the finest private library in the world. £35.95 per person. Alnwick OR Cragside

There are 900 acres of grounds to explore; from formal gardens and a rockery, to sprawling woodlands. **Alternatively**, the town of **Alnwick** has many attractions including a magnificent Castle, (which was "Hogwarts" in the Harry Potter films), and the famous Alnwick Gardens with its spectacular cascade and treehouse.(Please note admissions are NOT included and there will be equal time to spend at either destination). £24.75 per person.
