Monday 26th August 2019

Bakewell & Haddon Hall

Thursday 5th September 2019

We start at picturesque Bakewell, situated on the River Wye, the largest town in the Peak District National Park, and home of the famous pudding. We then move on to Haddon Hall, regarded as one of the most perfect fortified medieval manor houses to survive. A guided tour will acquaint you with the history including fire, warfare, family misfortune, changing fashions and film and TV location use. (NB the Hall has steps to negotiate). £37.75 per person. Muncaster Castle OR Ravensglass & Eskdale Railway

The castle has been altered and extended from its historical origin as a Pele Tower. Alternatively you can enjoy a return trip on the historic Ravensglass and Eskdale Railway, one of the oldest and longest narrow gauge railways in England, with a chance to see some of the local wildlife. Deans Garden Centre & Sutton Park
