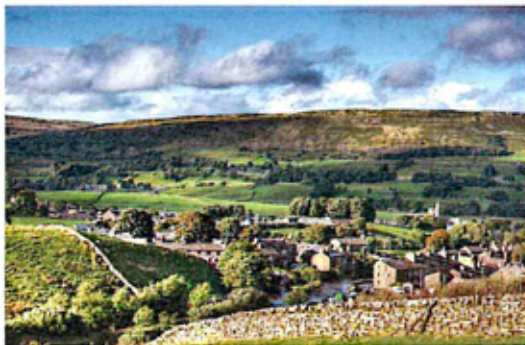

May

Monday 4th May. Scenic North Yorkshire Drive.

£29.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.30.

We visit beautiful Bedale, with its range of shops and cafes along the main street, before we travel to Richmond, passing through Masham and Leyburn and attractive scenery en route.

Saturday 9th May. North Yorks Moors Railway to Whitby.

£59.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

We take a ride by steam train on the North York Moors Railway from Pickering enjoying spectacular scenery to Whitby. The return journey, by coach takes in the majestic moorland views. (NB steam engine subject to availability).

Wednesday 13th May. Arnside & Cartmel.

£32.45pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Returns for 18.00.

Our day starts at genteel Arnside, a place with a number of independent shops, tasty snack outlets, views over the Kent Estuary towards the Lake District. We move onto Cartmel, A village with a rich history and an impressive 12th century priory.

Saturday 16th May. Portmerion.

£63.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.00 - Return for 20.00.

We travel through spectacular Snowdonian scenery to Portmeirion, a magnificent Italianate coastal village created by Sir Clough Williams-Ellis. With its cluster of colour washed houses, set around a central piazza, historic cottages and woodlands.

Wednesday 20th May. Ambleside & Holehird Gardens.

£39.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.30 - Return for 18.00.

Our first call is to popular Ambleside, situated at the northern end of Windermere, with lakeside views and a variety of shops. Later we visit nearby Holehird Gardens. Its features include a Rock Garden, Walled Garden and a paddock with trial beds. NB From the coach drop off point there will be a 400 yd walk up a steeply sloping tarmac drive.

Saturday 23rd May. Beverley on Market Day.

£28.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.00.

We travel to historic Beverley, with its beautiful Minster, on Market Day. There are plenty of stalls in a friendly and vibrant atmosphere, plus the Minster to explore.

Monday 25th May. Scenic Drive - Forest of Bowland to Morecambe.

£32.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

With a call at Settle for a mid-morning break, we take a scenic drive through Slaidburn and the beautiful Forest of Bowland to Morecambe, where amongst its attractions is the restored promenade with glorious views across the bay.

Wednesday 27th May. Yorkshire Lavender & Nunnington Hall.

£47.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return 18.00. NT reduction - £10.00

Set in 60 acres overlooking the Vale of York, Yorkshire Lavender has lavender fields, carefully curated gardens, as well as a tea room and a wide selection of plants and gifts. Nunnington Hall is a picturesque manor house with a walled garden and meadows.

Saturday 30th May. Northallerton & Saltburn by the Sea.

£34.95pp. Depart code B. Departs 09.00 - Return 18.30.

We make a morning call at the popular market town of Northallerton, before continuing on to Saltburn by the Sea.

June

Wednesday 3rd June. Llandudno.

£43.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return 20.00.

A jewel amongst Victorian resorts, Llandudno has a sweeping promenade, a beautiful pier and the Great Orme headland rising abruptly above the town. There are a variety of attractions for to enjoy.

Saturday 6th June. The Lakes & Keswick.

£40.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.30 - Return for 19.30.

We enjoy the beautiful scenery of the Lakes, with a call at Grasmere, on the way to the delightful market town of Keswick situated on the edge of Derwentwater.

Wednesday 10th June.

Matlock Bath & Heights of Abraham. £51.95pp.

Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 18.00.

Matlock Bath has been called "little Switzerland" on account of its steep wooded hillsides, and magnificent views from the top of them. The town's long high street has quirky shops, as well as a peaceful river side path. Above the town are The Heights of Abraham, a hilltop park of 60 acres which we reach by cable car. Here you can explore the Great Masson Cavern and enjoy the views over the Derwent Valley.



Wednesday 17th June. Sledmere House & Garden with Bridlington.

£54.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

You will have a guided tour of Sledmere House which is steeped in history and is full of unique collections of artwork, furniture and antiques, whilst the Walled Garden is renowned for its seasonal displays. Bridlington is a traditional resort with its stunning beaches and bustling harbour.

Saturday 20th June. Llangollen & Pontcysyllte Aqueduct.

£53.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return for 18.30.

In the picturesque town of Llangollen, you can enjoy the attractions which include a preserved railway, horse drawn canal boat trips and Plas Newydd House (admissions not included), plus riverside walks. To finish our day we join a narrow boat for a trip on the Llangollen Canal across the spectacular Pontcysyllte Aqueduct, known as the 'River in the Sky'. Built in 1805 it is the oldest and longest navigable aqueduct in the UK, as well as the highest in the world at over 100 feet.

Wednesday 24th June. "Another Place" & Liverpool.

£34.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

'Another Place' is the name for the 100 Antony Gormley statues situated on Crosby Beach – our day starts here when the tide is favourable for a viewing before heading to the Albert Dock area of Liverpool where you have time to peruse its many attractions.

Saturday 27th June. RHS Bridgewater.

£37.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 10.00 - Return for 16.30. RHS Discount -£13.00

The newest of the RHS gardens offers a range of attractions including extensive walled gardens, both flower and vegetable. There are woodland walks for you to enjoy together with the evolving Chinese garden. There is a lovely café by the side of a lake plus a shop and garden centre.

July

Saturday 4th July. Tynemouth.

£39.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

We visit one of the most popular towns on the North Tyneside coast. Tynemouth is situated at the mouth of the River Tyne, under the gaze of the ruined medieval priory and is steeped in maritime history, plus the award winning market is taking place today.

Wednesday 15th July. Great Yorkshire Show.

£56.45pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.15 - Return for 17.00.

Enjoy a day of celebration of agriculture, food, farming and countryside as well as the best in British livestock, forestry, hives and honey. There is a fabulous food hall, cookery demonstrations, garden shows and countryside pursuits.

Saturday 18th July.

Bakewell & Haddon Hall.

£57.95pp. Depart code B.

Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

Bakewell is a delightful market town situated on the River Wye, with a range of shopping including those selling the famous Bakewell Pudding. Haddon Hall is over 900 years old and is one of the country's most important stately homes, with Tudor architecture and an Elizabethan Walled Garden.



Thursday 23rd July. Burnby Hall Gardens & Bridlington.

£44.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

Burnby Hall Gardens are situated in the charming town of Pocklington, and is a seven times winner of RHS Yorkshire in Bloom award. The grounds comprise of upper and lower lakes, which are famous for waterlilies and are set in nine acres of woodlands and gardens. From here, we travel to the ever popular resort of Bridlington where you will have a chance to take in a variety of attractions.

Saturday 25th July. Carlisle to Settle Railway.

£62.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 08.00 - Return for 18.30.

We travel with a break en route to the City of Carlisle. It is famous for its castle, cathedral and shopping and you will have time to explore before we join our train for the iconic journey to Settle. For a change we are travelling North to South through the spectacular scenery. The route takes us over the famous Ribbleshead Viaduct and through Dent Station, the highest station in England. At Settle we join the coach for the rest of our return journey.

Wednesday 29th July. Oakham & Rutland Water Cruise.

£59.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

Oakham is the county town of England's smallest county and famous for its architecture and individual shopping, plus today is market day. We enjoy a cruise on Rutland Water which provides attractive scenery and a wide variety of wildlife, whilst enjoying a fruit scone /jam/cream with tea/coffee.

August

Saturday 1st August. Scarborough on Yorkshire Day.

£35.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

We visit the ever popular resort of Scarborough with its range of attractions to suit everybody. As today is Yorkshire Day keep a look out for any celebratory events.

Wednesday 5th August. Yorkshire Wildlife Park.

£49.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.30.

A chance to take 'a walk on the wild side' to see how animals are adapting to Yorkshire. There are over 400 animals and 70 different species from glorious Amur Tigers to majestic Polar Bears.

Saturday 8th August. Port Sunlight.

£47.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Returns for 18.30.

Port Sunlight is a model village founded by William Lever for his workers at the Sunlight Soaps factory. Known for its unique architecture with over 900 listed buildings and attractions including the Lady Lever Art Gallery and Port Sunlight Museum. There will be a guided tour on the coach for you to enjoy.

Wednesday 12th August. Llangollen & Llangollen Railway.

£58.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

Travel over the Pennines and into the lush green hills of the Welsh Borders to Llangollen, a small town with a selection of shops and attractions, including the heritage Llangollen Railway, where we will take a lovely scenic round trip to Corwen through the beautiful Dee Valley.

Saturday 15th August. Morpeth & Wallington Hall.

£65.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 08.30 - Return for 20.00. NT Deduction -£19.00

Morpeth is an historic market town, with attractive buildings in Northumberland situated on the river Wansbeck. Wallington Hall is a Grade I listed building, with a rich collection of, artworks, books and curiosities. The grounds include a magnificent Walled Garden whilst the woodland are home to a variety of wildlife including woodpeckers and red squirrels.

Wednesday 19th August. Scampston Walled Garden & Filey.

£45.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

Within the walled garden there is the calm of the 'silent garden' and an arresting perennial meadow. Outside the Walled Garden there is the traditional Hall gardens and 'Capability' Brown parkland, with highlights including a Palladian Bridge and lakes. Filey is an ever popular resort with traditional seaside attractions.

Saturday 22nd August. Southport at Flower Show Time.

£34.25pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 19.00.

Southport offers a mix of shops on Lord Street plus the attractions of a traditional seaside resort. Our visit coincides with the famous annual flower show with its huge range of displays, stalls, exhibits and show gardens. (Admission is NOT included and it is advisable to have booked your tickets in advance).

Wednesday 26th August. Whitby.

£37.25pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return 19.00.

Travelling across the North Yorkshire Moors, taking in the spectacular scenery we visit Whitby with its numerous attractions. These include the ruins of the Abbey and St Mary's Church at the top of the 199 steps, whilst the town offers a range of shops and cafes to enjoy including national award winning fish and chip shops.

Aug & Sept

Saturday 29th August. Scenic Drive to Clitheroe & Settle.

£28.25pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 17.30.

We start with a visit to Clitheroe, known for its castle, independent shops and market. We then take in the scenery via Bradford Fell and Slaidburn, on our way to Settle, where there will be further time to browse.

Monday 31st August. Scenic Dales Drive Grassington to Harrogate.

£25.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 17.30.

First call of the day is in the quaint village of Grassington – a popular spot for walkers and fans of "All Creatures Great and Small". Our drive takes in the stunning dales views from Greenhow Hill and of Nidderdale to our second call, the attractive regal town of Harrogate.

Wednesday 2nd September. Barton Grange Garden Centre & Cleveleys.

£34.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Returns for 19.00.

Barton Grange in Lancashire is a garden centre with the 'wow' factor plus a farm shop, cook shop and restaurant. We then enjoy the afternoon in Cleveleys taking in the sea air and attractions.

Saturday 5th September. Brookside Garden Centre & The Churnet Valley Railway.

£53.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

We start our day in Cheshire, with a break en route at the Brookside Garden Centre, Poynton, before travelling on to Staffordshire for a journey on the heritage Churnet Valley Railway. Our round trip is a reminder of times gone by with a backdrop of delightful English countryside.

Saturday 12th September. "Brief Encounter" & Levens Hall.

£47.75pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

We travel to Carnforth Railway Station, where the classic film 'Brief Encounter' was filmed. Here the restaurant room has been faithfully restored to its 1940's period glory, whilst The Heritage Visitor Centre provides additional memories. Levens Hall is a family owned manor house with the world's oldest topiary gardens.

Friday 18th September. Harrogate Autumn Flower Show at Newby Hall.

£50.75pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 18.00.

The Autumn Show will be held in the grounds of Newby Hall, where you will also be able to enjoy Newby Hall's award winning gardens. There will be a Grand Flower Pavilion, live talks and an amazing range of garden related exhibitors as well as a covered Food Market.

Wednesday 23rd September. Oswaldtwistle Mill & Guided Tour

£30.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.30.

The former weaving mill has over 100 retailers under a single roof featuring clothing, food, gifts and household. Included in our visit is a guided tour on the coach of the beautiful Ribble Valley, giving you a chance to take in the scenery and listen to tales of historic Ribchester, Stonyhurst and Whalley.

Sunday 27th September. Sunday Lunch Cruise on the River Trent

£60.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return 17.30.

We take a 3 hour leisurely informative cruise on the River Trent from Colwick (near Nottingham) and enjoy a traditional Sunday Roast Dinner whilst admiring the passing scenery. Menu choice is Roast Pork Loin OR Chicken Breast – served with roast potatoes, minted potatoes, yorks pud, two veg and gravy. Black forest gateaux & cream, tea/coffee.

October

Wednesday 7th October. Bury Market including Fish & Chips.

£41.95pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.30 - Return 18.00.

From the exotic to the everyday Bury Market has it all , with over 200 stalls you are sure to find whatever you want at bargain prices. From here we travel to the award winning Olympus Fish and Chip restaurant in Bolton for a traditional meal of cod, chips, peas, bread and butter with tea or coffee.

Saturday 10th October. North York Moors Railway to Whitby.

£59.25pp. Depart code B. Departs 09.00 - Return 19.00.

We take a ride by steam train on the North York Moors Railway from Pickering, enjoying spectacular scenery to Whitby. Once in Whitby you will have a chance to enjoy the attractions of this delightful resort. The return journey, by coach, takes in the majestic moorland views. (NB steam engine subject to availability)

Saturday 17th October.

Kendal on Market Day & Bowness on Windermere.

£33.25pp. Depart code A.

Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.30.

With a hint of Autumn in the air, we travel to the Lake District, starting on its edge in the market town of Kendal which hosts both an indoor and outdoor market. Onward then to Bowness, situated on the shores of Lake Windermere, which has a range of attractions including individual shops, boat trips and lakeside walks. (No admissions included).



Saturday 24th October. Hull & The Deep.

£45.95pp. Depart code B. Depart 09.30 - Return for 17.00.

The focus for our visit is The Deep – it is home to thousands of sea creatures from the shallow tropical lagoons to the darkest deeps of the cold oceans. You will also have time in Hull to explore the numerous attractions of this vibrant city.

Thursday 29th October. Pendle Mill, Blackpool & The Lights.

£36.45pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 20.00.

We visit Pendle Village Mill Shopping Centre, where departments offer clothing, home goods , a garden centre and cafe. Then, onwards to Blackpool to enjoy its attractions. We will then enjoy a drive through the world famous lights of Blackpool from the comfort of our coach.

Saturday 31st October.

Autumn Colours of Bowland Forest & Bay View Garden Centre.

£31.25pp. Depart code A. Depart 09.00 - Return for 18.00.

We travel to Whalley for a mid-morning break, before continuing through the beautiful autumn colours of the Forest of Bowland, to Bay View Garden Centre, which is family owned and overlooks Morecambe Bay. Here there is an extensive range of plants, gifts and garden sundries. whilst the restaurant has panoramic views over the bay.
